

May 1, 2012

The Jerseyville City Council met in regular session on May 1, 2012, at 6:00 p.m. in the Jerseyville City Hall.

Roll call: Present were Commissioners Yvonne Hartmann, Bill Russell, Glen Ketchum and Mayor Perdun. Also present was City Attorney, George Wittman. Comm. Macias was absent.

Mayor Perdun led the opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion was made by Comm. Russell, and seconded by Comm. Ketchum to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting on April 17, 2012. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, and seconded by Comm. Russell to approve the minutes of the special meeting held on April 30, 2012. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, seconded by Comm. Ketchum to approve the bills as presented. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

Mayor Perdun read and signed a Proclamation naming the week of April 29<sup>th</sup> – May 5<sup>th</sup> as City Clerk's week. A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, seconded by Comm. Ketchum approving the week of April 29-May 5 as City Clerk's week. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, the motion carried.

Mayor Perdun read an explanation of the proposed ordinance to amend Chapter 12, Section 10, of the Code of Ordinances setting forth a rental housing registration and systematic inspection program. It was decided to hold a public hearing before the next meeting on May 15, 2012, starting at 5:00 p.m. for input from the public.

A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, seconded by Comm. Ketchum, to approve the Wal-Mart Fundraiser to be held on 5/6/12 at the intersection of St. Hwy #67 & #16 and W County Rd & St. Hwy #109 7a.m. to 4 p.m. to raise money for the Children's Miracle Network. They have already submitted their proof of insurance to the City Clerk. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, seconded by Comm. Russell, to approve a Resolution closing St. Hwy #67 for the Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 28<sup>th</sup> from 8:45 to 9:45 a.m. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, seconded by Comm. Russell, to approve Section 504 Grievance Procedure for the IKE Grant Project. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

Discussion was held on a proposed ordinance to modify the abatement proceedings for nuisance weeds and vegetation by amending Title 5, Chapter 5, Section 6 to provide that the notice dealing with this section may be served by personal service, certified mail with a return receipt, or posted on the property. After the discussion, it was the consensus of the Council that the service by certified mail was too expensive and should read by "first class" mail. A motion was made by Comm. Russell, seconded by Comm. Ketchum, to that effect and the roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, and the motion carried. Ord #1586.

Discussion was held on an ordinance to modify the abatement proceedings for inoperable motor vehicles. A motion was made by Comm. Russell, seconded by Comm. Hartmann, to table this ordinance for 2 weeks. Roll call vote showed all present voted aye, no nays, the motion carried.
