

The Jerseyville City Council met in regular session on November 26, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. in the Jerseyville City Hall.

Roll call: Present were Commissioners Bill Russell, Glen Ketchum, Andy Macias and Mayor Perdun. Also present was City Attorney, George Wittman.

Comm. Macias led the opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion was made by Comm. Ketchum, and seconded by Comm. Macias, to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting November 12, 2013. Roll call vote showed all ayes, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Russell, seconded by Comm. Ketchum, to approve the bills as presented. Roll call vote showed all ayes, no nays, motion carried.
