The Jerseyville City Council held a Special Council meeting on March 3, 2016, at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall.

Roll call: Present were Comm. Kevin Stork, Steve Pohlman, Richard Perdun, Gary Goetten and Mayor Bill Russell. Also present was City Attorney William Strang.

With deadlines that were quickly approaching for application for grants from the USDOT, the purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the authorization of Bartlett & West to apply for these grants in order to meet the deadlines.

A motion was made by Comm. Perdun and seconded by Comm. Goetten to approve authorization for Bartlett & West to register the City of Jerseyville at grants.gov and complete applications for USDOT grants, including Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grants and Nationally Significant Freight and Highway Projects (FASTLANE) grants under the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FASTACT). Roll call vote showed all ayes, no nays, motion carried.
