

JULY 9, 2013

The Jerseyville City Council met in regular session on July 9, 2013, at 4:30 p.m. in the Jerseyville City Hall.

Roll call: Present were Commissioners Bill Russell, Glen Ketchum, Yvonne Hartmann, and Andy Macias and Mayor Richard Perdun. City Attorney George Wittman was also present.

Comm. Macias led the opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion was made by Comm. Russell and seconded by Comm. Hartmann to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting on June 25, 2013. Roll call vote Russell, aye; Ketchum, aye; Hartmann, aye; Macias, aye; Mayor Perdun abstained from the vote, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Hartmann, seconded by Comm. Macias, to approve the bills as presented. Roll call vote showed voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

City Resident, Debra Akers appeared before the Council with a petition she had circulated for signatures showing support in an effort to widen & repair County Road east of Maple Summit Rd. and asking for a bike path/sidewalk to be installed. Comm. Macias explained how many attempts have been made by the City to acquire funding to handle such a repair project. The Council thanked Ms. Akers for obtaining the signatures and approaching the Council with the petition.

Steve Pegram then spoke to the Council about the fourth annual "Got Faith Festival" to be held at the American Legion on August 4<sup>th</sup>. Russell, to approve donating \$700. Roll call vote showed all ayes, no nays, motion carried.
