

JERSEYVILLE CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

The Jerseyville City Council held their regular meeting on Tuesday, July 26, 2022, after having held a public hearing 5:45 p.m. for filing the appropriations ordinance, at the Jerseyville City Hall at 6:00 p.m. via teleconference due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The public was invited to attend by calling the teleconference phone number.

ROLL CALL: Present were Commissioners Kevin Stork, Steve Pohlman, Zachary Crawford, and Mayor William Russell. City Attorney William Strang was also present. Nick Bexheti was absent.

Commissioner Pohlman led the opening prayer and Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve the minutes from the meeting held Tuesday, July 12, 2022. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Crawford, to approve the bills as presented for July 26, 2022, in the amount of \$459,112.91. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Crawford, to approve the certified estimate of revenues for FY 2022-23. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve the filing of the FY 2022-23 appropriations ordinance after holding a public hearing Tuesday, July 26th, at 5:45 p.m. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve a tourism grant request from Steve Pegram of Got Faith? in the amount of \$3,002.00. Mr. Steve Pegram was present to speak to the Council of the upcoming events his organization will be sponsoring to attract visitors to our community. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Crawford, to approve the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) program closeout for the fiscal year 2021-22 and related documents. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve an easement and right-of-way agreement between the City of Jerseyville and Illinois American Water Company (IAWC) as part of the vacated are of Pine Street. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

In other business, Director of Public Works Bob Mans reported he has received notification the City of Jerseyville is still on track to receive revenue from a legislative initiative supported by Rodney Davis which will help fund Hollow Avenue Project extension to City limits, new roof at the Susnig Complex, and Pleasant Street Drainage Phase II project. The City has submitted a grant through Illinois American Water Foundation for a splash pad and hoping to hear in the next 60 days.

No public comment.

A motion was made by Comm. Stork, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to go into closed session to discuss personnel/contract negotiations. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.
