

JERSEYVILLE CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 23, 2022

The Jerseyville City Council held their regular meeting on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, at the Jerseyville City Hall at 6:00 p.m. via teleconference due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The public was invited to attend by calling the teleconference phone number.

ROLL CALL: Present were Commissioners Kevin Stork, Steve Pohlman, Zachary Crawford (teleconference), and Nick Bexheti. Mayor William Russell was absent. City Attorney William Strang was also present.

Commissioner Pohlman led the opening prayer and Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

A motion was made by Comm. Bexheti, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve the minutes from the meeting held Tuesday, August 9, 2022. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Bexheti, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve the bills as presented for August 23, 2022, in the amount of \$341,021.66. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Bexheti, seconded by Comm. Crawford, to approve the notice of award to lowest bidder Allegiant Contracting, 6614 Clayton Road, St. Louis, Missouri, for demolition of residential structures program 2022 and for Mayor, City Clerk, and Director of Building and Zoning to sign associated paperwork. The notice of award includes the properties located at 215 Snedeker Street, 702 East Prairie Street, and 202 McGill Street. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Pohlman, seconded by Comm. Bexheti, to approve Resolution A as presented with a 3% raise for two years. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Bexheti, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve the closure of East Arch Street from State Street to alley and alley adjacent to the Fire Department from 12:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. for Rock the Block on Friday, September 9, 2022. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Pohlman, seconded by Comm. Crawford, to approve the closure of City Center Plaza parking lot F from 12:00 p.m. Thursday, October 6th until 10:00 p.m. Friday, October 7th; and Jefferson Street from Spruce Street to Snedeker Street from 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday, October 7th for Rock the Block on October 7th. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Bexheti, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve a request from Dennis Ford on behalf of the Jerseyville Lions Club for a fundraiser on October 21st from 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the intersection of West County Road and Illinois Route 109 for the annual Lions Club Candy Day. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

A motion was made by Comm. Bexheti, seconded by Comm. Pohlman, to approve the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Board of a request from Jon Shrimpton for changes in variance at the northeast corner of McBride and Dorothy Street and as follows: Adams Street 25' to 15', Curtis Street 30' to 15', Dorothy Street 15' to 5', McBride Street 25' to 15', and Mane Attraction 15' to 5'. Mr. Shrimpton was present to speak to the Council describing what the storage facility will resemble. Roll call vote showed all voted aye, no nays, motion carried.

No other business.
